Abstracts for presentations should be no more than 500 words and should include:

- Title of presentation
- Author's name and contact information
- 200 word biographical statement (for speaker introductions)

Student submissions should include:

- Title of research/studies
- Student's name, university and contact information
- Statement of future professional or research interest

Professional presentation lengths may vary from 30-60 minutes (student presentations 10-15 minutes); please indicate the intended length with submission; we anticipate including 10 minutes of presentation time for Q&A session. Presentations will be in PowerPoint and will be presented from a central PC.

All abstracts should be submitted via email to [aptwglsymposium@gmail.com](mailto:aptwglsymposium@gmail.com) with the subject "Symposium 2017 abstract". Deadlines and notification dates will be:

- Deadline to submit: January 13, 2017
- Abstract response: January 27, 2017
- Speaker confirmation: February 3, 2017
